

Solar bus, a home on the go

IIT-Bombay Prof. Chetan Singh Solanki has been travelling across 25 cities in India in the solar bus since November 26, 2020 to spread awareness about energy access, security and sustainability, climate change and solutions to reduce carbon emissions. He has travelled to 30 countries in his bus earlier, and intends to trigger a mass movement to fight global energy issue over the next 11 years. He calls his travels 'Solarvas', a takeoff from 'Vanvas' probably. The bus also houses a small demonstration with basic units about how embracing of solar energy solutions on a large scale can alleviate climate change. 
